Silvercrest Elementary PTA General Meeting Minutes September 17, 2020

The General Meeting of the Silvercrest PTA was called to order on September 17, 2020 at 6:32 p.m. via Zoom video conferencing hosted by PTA President, Monica Rasmussen and Victoria Tran, Secretary, being present. A quorum was established.

Angela Perez, President-Elect, led the members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the PTA General Board meeting held on May 14, 2020 were approved as submitted by the committee of Monica Rasmussen, Victoria Tran and Melissa Henry. The minutes stand approved as submitted.

Ms. Tran moved that the Silvercrest PTA Records Retention Policy be adopted for the 2020-21 school year. Only Mr. Restrepo opposed. The motion was seconded and carried.

Marla Jones announced the Financial Reconciliation Report from the period of July 1,2019 to July 31, 2020. The records are found to be substantially correct with a few minor recommendations. Ms. Jones moved that the Silvercrest PTA 2019-2020 Financial Reconciliation Report be adopted. The motion was seconded and carried.

Committee Reports

Fall Fundaiser (Booserthon), Sarah Hawks, 1st Vice-President:

The PISD suspended all fundraising until further notice during the Corona Virus Pandemic of 2020. In addition to the teacher being overwhelmed with additional guidelines and responsibilities and the financial distress of parents. Sarah Hawks announced that the Fall Fundraiser, Booserthon, is postponed to Fall 2021. PTA will not lose the deposit made for Fall 2020. If the PISD allows fundraising in the Spring, PTA may plan a small simple fundraiser.

New Business

President Rasmussen introduced a motion for the PTA to offer a gift of \$25,000 to the Silvercrest Elementary School, allocating \$15,000 for the first phrase of playground shade covering and \$10,000 for the Teacher Wishlist (Scholastic online magazine, Generation Genius and other items). The motion was presented at the General Meeting for a vote of approval. The motion was seconded and carried.

Principal Announcements, Lori Campbell

Ms. Campbell thanked the PTA for offering the sale of Silvercrest-themed masks. She shared the teachers' gratitude to the PTA for arranging the Jax Burger food truck to serve the teachers dinner on the Virtual Meet the Teacher Night. Ms. Campbell expressed thanks for the PTA's gift for the playground covering and the funds for the Teacher Wishlist items. Lastly, Principal Campbell thanked everyone for a great start to a very unusual year during this unprecedented time.
