*Message: Healthy habits like reading help you expand your imagination and make you feel happy.*



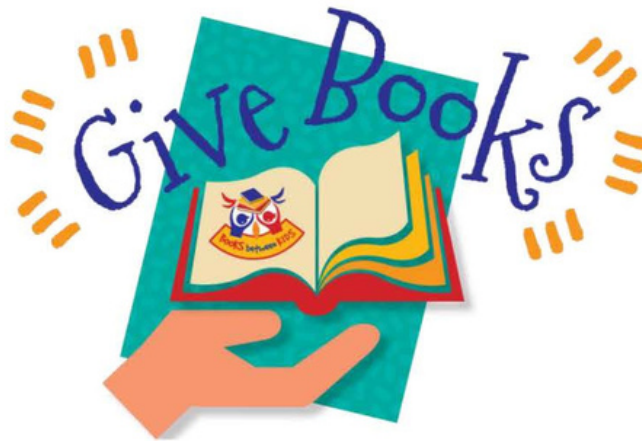
# Books Between Kids Book Drive

## Books we cannot use:

- Books with torn binding, pages or covers
- Books with excess writing
- Books with yellowed/discolored pages
- Religious books
- Workbooks, coloring books, sticker books, puzzle books, etc.
- Reference books, textbooks, or outdated non-fiction books
- Teacher or parenting books/materials (ex: flash cards)
- Audiobooks, DVDs, CDs, etc.
- Books with content that's inappropriate for children
